The Global Scale of English

The Global Scale of English (GSE) is a standardized, granular scale that measures English language proficiency. Unlike some other frameworks that measure English proficiency in broad bands, the Global Scale of English identifies what a learner can do at each point on a scale from 10-90, across each of the four skills: listening, reading, speaking and writing.

Gerunds and infinitives come from verb forms that function as nouns in a sentence, often as direct objects.

Gerund = a **g** form of a verb
Infinitive = **t**o + a base form
the words to point the teacher gives

Use a gerund after the following verbs and expressions: avoid, dream, dislike, don't mind, enjoy, feel like, practice, quit, suggest.

Use an infinitive after the following verbs and expressions: agree, be sure, choose, decide, expect, hope, learn, need, plan, seem, want, wish, would like.

Other verbs and expressions can be followed by either a gerund or an infinitive: begin, can't stand, continue, hate, like, love, prefer, start.
